

# Millbrook Parish Council Consultations & Improvements

Evidence expressed in both the 2004 Village plan consultation results and the 2008 village plan update consultation show that preservation and improvement for Millbrook Lake and surrounding parkland were ranked the highest in a list of village priorities.

In July 2004 over 30 volunteers from the Millbrook Village Plan Committee delivered **926 questionnaires**, 1 for every household.

499 responses received – (including 49 from 11-16)

During the August rainy season a team of local people helped to record all the replies on a specially designed database using the Millbrook Computer facilities.

48 of the young people who responded said they would like more to do at evenings and weekends – this was also identified during the Village Plan Action Fair (No 4 in priority rating)

Millbrook & Torpoint Youth Project partnership to increase provision for youth in Millbrook. In 2006 MPC committed to funding the employment of a youth support worker.

Having completed a Village Plan questionnaire back in 2004, a document was produced in November 2008 to give the community an opportunity to prioritise which services and amenities they think were most in need of improvement in Millbrook. Questions were divided into the following sections; Environment & lake, Housing and Community Services, Traffic & Transport and Recreation and Leisure.



Funding achieved for wheeled sports facility in June 2008.

Village plan update questionnaire produced 2008 and distributed 2009

Completion from grant funding of Millbrook Play park improvements (known as 'The Tractor Park' in June 2010).

Traffic calming was identified as 3<sup>rd</sup> most important in priority in the Village Plan – MPC listened to concerns and addressed these issues

Analysis of Village Plan Update questionnaire completed

148 responses

Following a 3 year process involving a Big Lottery Community Spaces Grant Funding in January 2014 Millbrook Lake Conservation Group and Millbrook Parish Council celebrated the completion of Millbrook Lake Island Restoration works.

Village Plan Review Questionnaire

93 responses

Document was compiled detailing analysis of consultation results from Review questionnaire

Nearly 95% responded they would like to see improvements to the edges and island of Millbrook.

In January 2010 Millbrook Lake Conservation Group was founded. In partnership with Millbrook Parish Council Big Lottery funding applications were submitted.

November 2010 – Millbrook Lake Conservation Group and Millbrook Parish Council hosted a consultation open evening.
